### What are the extra services?

The table below gives details of our services and the charges. Most of these services are provided only when you ask for them. We take the charge when we provide the service.

### International payments

Receiving payments from abroad:

From Bank of Ireland accounts	£6
From other banks	£15

Transferring payments abroad:

If you ask us to send a payment to another country	£25
If you ask us to send a payment to Bank of Ireland in the Republic of Ireland	£10

(If the details of the bank that the payment is going to are quoted incorrectly, we will charge an extra £10.)

### Euro payments

If a payment request meets the following criteria no charges will apply:

- The payment is in Euros and is less than EUR50,000 in value
- You provide the International Bank Account Number of the beneficiary (the person you are paying)
- You provide the Bank Identifier Code of the beneficiary's bankers
- You provide the beneficiary's name and address
- You do not specify the value date
- When completing or filling in the instruction you must leave the charges blank

Bank of Ireland standard charges will apply if:

- the payment is more than EUR50,000 or is in a currency other than Euros;
- you ask for the payment to be made on the same day or the next day; or
- you do not supply the beneficiary's IBAN or BIC or if you supply an incorrect IBAN or BIC
